What is a dental implant?

Do you have difficulty in eating? Are you embarrassed with missing or loose teeth? Do you have dentures which you just can't get on with or a tooth your dentist has told you needs to come out, and you don't like the idea of shaving down healthy teeth for a traditional fixed bridge? A dental implant may be the solution for you. It is an artificial tooth root that is placed into the jaw to support a replacement tooth/teeth.

Dental implants are the gold standard for the replacement of teeth and offer a predictable and long lasting solution for restoring missing teeth. They can allow you to smile, talk and eat more confidently and with better comfort. Many of our patients talk about the life changing benefits to their self esteem and general wellbeing.

Who is suitable for dental implants?

Dental implants are suitable for individuals who have lost one or more teeth, have good oral health, and have adequate bone density and quality to support the implant. Certain medical conditions can contraindicate treatment or increase the complexity of your care. Your eligibility and suitability for treatment will be assessed thoroughly on an implant consultation with the dentist.

What's involved?

You will initially have a consultation with the dentist to assess your oral health and suitability for treatment. This will include x rays where needed and good clinical photos and a 3d scan of your teeth. A bespoke treatment plan will be created and if you choose to go ahead, a CT scan will be arranged for you to digitally plan the position and size of the implant needed for your mouth. The implant is then placed under local anaesthetic, sedation is an option should you wish to be more relaxed during the procedure. You will then be reviewed at a later date and the final restoration will then be placed.

How much is an implant?

The price of dental implants can vary based on how many missing teeth you have, the bone and gum condition of your mouth and the materials chosen. As a guide, a single dental implant with a crown starts from £2600.
