

Advanced Periodontal Services

Here at Silk Dental, we provide advanced procedures to address and treat complex or severe gum and periodontal issues. Our principal dentist, Hassan, has undergone a diploma in Periodontology, allowing him to treat the most severe cases as well as reconstruct missing gum tissue.

Why should I consider treatment?

In most cases, treatment and regular maintenance with a dental therapist will stabilise and maintain your gum condition. In a small number of cases, this approach is not effective and more specialised intervention is required. This may be the difference between losing a tooth or teeth or maintaining them for several more years. Dental implants are a fantastic tooth replacement, but they do not give the same sensation as teeth, and it can be significantly cheaper to try and save a tooth with more advanced gum disease treatments. Advanced gum disease treatments can also help prolong the lifespan of implants.

Teeth are not the only thing which make a beautiful smile. Your gums help creates that symmetrical healthy smile. Advanced periodontal procedures can be used to move the gum to where it should sit around a tooth or implant, creating that harmonious smile.

Why are the health of your gums so important?

Your gums play a crucial role in your oral health and overall well-being:

- (i) They provide essential support for your teeth, helping to anchor them in place. The gum tissue, along with the underlying bone, forms a stable foundation for your teeth, ensuring they remain in their proper position.
- (ii) The gums act as a barrier that helps prevent bacteria and other harmful microorganisms from entering your bloodstream through the oral tissues. When gums are healthy, they are better equipped to fight off infections and maintain oral health.
- (iii) Healthy gums provide a frame for the teeth. Gums that are pink, firm, and well-contoured enhance the overall appearance of your smile.
- (iv) Healthy gums contribute to good oral hygiene by providing a seal around the base of the teeth, which helps protect the sensitive tooth roots and underlying bone from damage and decay
- (v) Research has shown that there is a strong link between gum health and overall health. Poor gum health has been associated with an increased risk of certain systemic conditions, such as heart disease & diabetes. By maintaining healthy gums, you may also be supporting your overall health and well-being.

What types of conditions can be treated?

- (i) Managment of complex and advanced periodontal disease, not responding to standard hygiene and home management
- (ii) Reducing gum recession where the gum has receded to the extent the roots are exposed and are affecting the appearance may benefit from a grafting procedure to improve aesthetics and improve symptoms related to root exposure eg. hyper sensitivity.
- (iii) Crown lengthening procedures to carefully move the gum line to allow the provision of more advanced restorations where space is insufficient otherwise.



What do we offer?

Full mouth disinfection | This is a non-surgical deep cleaning procedure performed to remove plaque, tartar, and bacterial toxins from the root surfaces of the teeth and the gum pockets.

Periodontal Surgery | Periodontal surgery is a specialised procedure to treat localised advanced gum disease (periodontitis) or address gum and bone-related issues around the teeth and dental implants.

Gum Grafting | This procedure involves taking gum tissue from one area of the mouth and transplanting it to an area with gum recession.

Crown Lengthening | Crown lengthening is a procedure to expose more of the tooth's crown by reshaping the gum and bone. It may be done for cosmetic reasons or to prepare a tooth for a dental restoration.

Guided Tissue Regeneration | This technique involves placing a barrier membrane between the gum tissue and the bone during periodontal surgery. The barrier encourages the growth of new bone and tissue in areas where they have been lost due to disease.
