Root canal treatment is often the last chance to save a natural tooth. Avoid extraction with timely endodontic treatment.

What is endodontic treatment?

Endodontics is a branch of dentistry concerned with tooth pulp. When this pulp becomes infected with bacteria, this can lead to acute pain, and the tooth nerve will eventually die. When a tooth dies, extraction and replacement is the only other option.

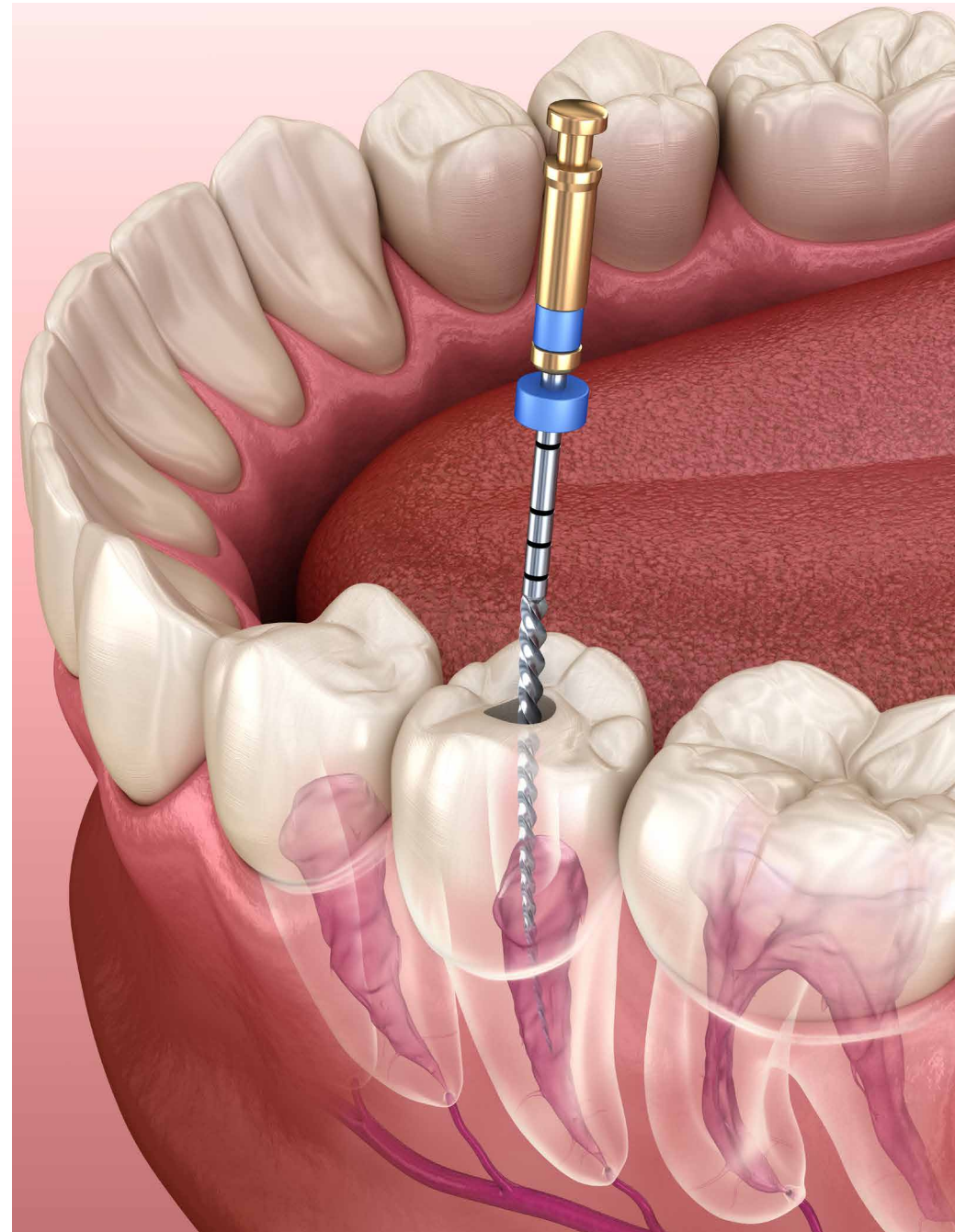
Endodontics is a conservative treatment that can preserve your natural teeth for longer.

When is root canal treatment needed?

When you have an infection within your tooth root, your choices for treatment are root canal therapy or extraction. An infection in the tooth pulp is usually accompanied with acute pain and occasionally swelling in your cheek or jaw. If the pain goes away temporarily, this doesn't mean the problem is fixed. It is usually an indication that the tooth nerve has died, and the pain can return more severely later.

With adequate anaesthesia, the procedure of a root canal does not hurt. 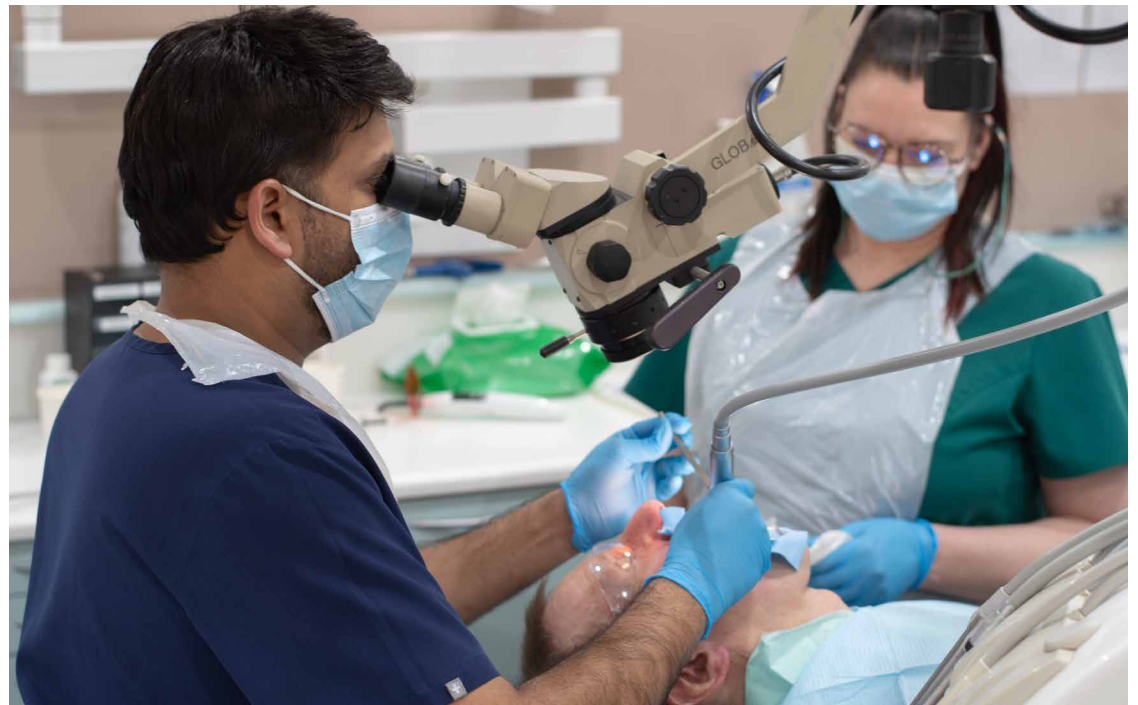

Other advanced endodontic procedures

As well as complex root treatments, we also provide Endodontic apical surgery, also known as apicectomy or root-end surgery. It is a surgical procedure performed by specialists to treat persistent infections or inflammation in the root tip (apex) of a tooth. It's typically done when conventional root canal treatment isn't sufficient to resolve the issue.
