COMPOSITE BONDING

Composite bonding uses a special tooth-coloured resin applied directly to your teeth. This is moulded and shaped into the ideal shape and then set with a UV light, allowing for same-day restorations.

What is composite bonding?

Composite bonding is a cost-effective cosmetic dentistry technique that allows for same-day restorations and can fix minor imperfections for a fraction of the cost of treatments such as orthodontics, veneers or crowns.

How does composite bonding work?

Composite resin is matched to the natural tooth colour and then placed directly over the teeth with no preparation of your natural teeth. Your dentist will then shape as required before setting with a UV light. Once set, the resin will look and feel like your natural teeth. However, this is not a permanent restoration.



What is composite bonding used for?

Composite resin can help to conceal a range of aesthetic concerns, including chips, cracks, gaps, discolouration, worn enamel and crooked teeth. If you have minor imperfections and don't want to undergo extensive dental work, this is the ideal cost-effective treatment for you.

DENTAL HYGIENE


What can a dental hygienist do?

The dental hygienist's role is to keep your teeth healthy and clean. At Silk Dental we use the EMS GBT Protocol during hygiene appointments. This is an innovative dental cleaning technique that surpasses the limitations of traditional scale and polishing. As part of your appointment we:

- *Remove tartar from the surface of the tooth*
- *Provide advice about how you brush your teeth and maintain good oral hygiene*
- *Give fluoride treatment to protect your teeth*
- *Offer advice on cosmetic and restorative treatments*
- *Help stabilise and improve all forms of gum disease*

What are Same Day Teeth?

A revolutionary advanced implant procedure which can replace an entire jaw of teeth with a fixed bridge all within one appointment. This is possible whether or not you have your own failing teeth or you have a set of dentures.

Why choose Same Day Teeth?

Same day teeth means surgery can be completed in one day, without the need for multiple procedures. If you currently have teeth, you can also avoid the need for a temporary denture which can be uncomfortable to wear. Due to the nature of the procedure large grafting procedures can also be avoided.

By having a fixed solution from day 1, we can restore you both the aesthetics and function immediately. Improving your confidence in both your appearance and ability to eat. Having a good strong set of teeth also improves your general health as you can eat a more rich and varied diet.

What are veneers?

Dental veneers are thin, custom-made shells typically made of porcelain that cover the front surface of a tooth and provide several advantages:

Cosmetic Enhancement | *Veneers can be used to improve the appearance of teeth that are discolored, stained, or have other aesthetic imperfections.*

Correction of Irregularities | *Veneers can correct minor dental imperfections such as chipped, cracked, unevenly shaped teeth, or small gaps.*

Minimally Invasive | *Compared to some other cosmetic procedures, veneers require minimal tooth structure removal.*

Customisation | *Veneers are custom-made to match the colour, shape, and size of your natural teeth.*

Durability | *Porcelain veneers are highly durable and can last for many years with proper care. They are resistant to stains and do not discolour easily.*

Quick Results | *The process typically takes only a few dental visits, and the results are often immediate.*

Natural Appearance | *Veneers can look very natural, and it can be difficult for others to distinguish them from your natural teeth.*

Stability | *Veneers can help stabilise and protect teeth with minor damage or wear, preventing further deterioration.*

However, veneers may not be suitable for everyone. A thorough evaluation by a dentist is necessary. Additionally, veneers are typically a cosmetic procedure, and may not address underlying dental health issues, such as decay or gum disease, which would need to be treated separately.

Boutique Whitening

We use Boutique, a professional, prescription-only whitening solutions that can penetrate the tooth's surface to oxidise and flush out staining particles. This minimises the risk of increased sensitivity or irritation to your teeth and allows for us to offer a guaranteed shading service.



How long before I see results?

After your initial consultation, it will take around two weeks for your custom trays to arrive. Then, you can pick up your teeth-whitening kit from the Dental Practice. If you choose Boutique Whitening Day, you will wear the trays for one hour per day for 3-4 weeks. If you select Boutique Whitening Night, you will wear the trays for up to 4 hours or overnight for 3-4 weeks.

INVISALIGN

Invisalign is an advanced clear aligner system to straighten your teeth

What is Invisalign?

Traditional fixed braces straighten your teeth using brackets and wires that apply pressure to the teeth. Invisalign uses a series of clear aligners that gradually move your teeth into the correct alignment. You can remove the aligners to eat, drink and brush your teeth. Before treatment begins, we take digital impressions and allow you to enjoy a sneak peek at your new smile.



What can Invisalign treat?

Invisalign can treat more than just simple orthodontic cases. It can treat a range of orthodontic issues, including gaps, rotations, over crowding, overbite, underbite, crossbite and open bites. Invisalign is suitable for teens who might not be eligible for NHS orthodontics or those who want to get started with treatment right away. Invisalign is also ideal for adults who want to achieve straighter teeth later in life.

How long does Invisalign take?

This all depends on your treatment plan. For a single arch with minor imperfections, you could see results in as little as six months. For more complex cases, it could take around two years to achieve the desired results.

What are Dental Implants?

Dental implants offer a solid, secure, and natural-looking solution for missing teeth. Implants build a fixed new tooth root, using strong titanium posts placed into your jawbone to support a crown, bridge, or denture. Over time, the titanium root fuses to the surrounding bone in the jaw, becoming a strong and durable foundation.




Why Choose Dental Implants?

SEDATION

Nervous about treatment or just want a long treatment to pass by quickly? Sedation might be just the solution for you.

Some people are so worried about visiting the dentist, they avoid attending regular appointments or getting vital treatment to protect the health of their teeth. If you have dental anxiety, IV sedation is a safe, effective way to make you feel completely relaxed and much more willing to undergo treatment.

What is Sedation dentistry?

Put simply, sedation dentistry uses medication to aid relaxation for patients during dental procedures. There are levels of sedation ranging from minimal to general anaesthesia.

Why choose to have sedation?

- Makes you feel completely relaxed and anxiety-free
- Rapid onset of the calming effects
- Level of sedation can be tailored to suit your needs
- Can help you forget the treatment process
- Allows you to communicate with the dentist

How does it work?

Your sedation dentist will place a cannula in your hand or arm before the procedure begins. Once administered, you will immediately feel more relaxed. We will then complete your dental procedure. Unlike a general anaesthetic, you are not asleep. Instead, you will feel drowsy and less alert. You might drift off to sleep, but you will be easily woken with a tap from the sedation dentist. Patients often report that they don't remember the procedure and that it went by very quickly.

PERIODONTICS

These are specialised treatments and procedures which look to address complex or severe gum and periodontal (supporting structures of the teeth) issues.

Why should I consider treatment?

In most cases, treatment and regular maintenance with a dental therapist will stabilise and maintain your gum condition. In a small number of cases, this approach is not effective and more specialised intervention is required. This may be the difference between losing a tooth or teeth or maintaining them for several more years. Advanced periodontal procedures can also be used to move the gum to where it should sit around a tooth or implant, creating that harmonious smile.

What we offer

Full mouth disinfection | *This is a non-surgical deep cleaning procedure performed to remove plaque, tartar, and bacterial toxins from the root surfaces of the teeth and the gum pockets. It is a common treatment for advanced gum disease (periodontitis) and can help resolve non responding areas*

Periodontal Surgery | *Periodontal surgery is a specialized procedure to treat localised advanced gum disease (periodontitis) or address gum and bone-related issues around the teeth and dental implants. It may involve techniques such as gum grafting, bone grafting, pocket reduction surgery, and gum flap surgery.*

Gum Grafting | *This procedure involves taking gum tissue from one area of the mouth and transplanting it to an area with gum recession. Gum grafting helps to cover exposed tooth roots, improve aesthetics, and protect the tooth's supporting structures.*

Crown Lengthening | *Crown lengthening is a procedure to expose more of the tooth's crown by reshaping the gum and bone. It may be done for cosmetic reasons or to prepare a tooth for a dental restoration.*

Guided Tissue Regeneration | *This technique involves placing a barrier membrane between the gum tissue and the bone during periodontal surgery. The barrier encourages the growth of new bone and tissue in areas where they have been lost due to disease.*

ENDODONTICS

This treatment is often the last chance to save a natural tooth. Avoid extraction with timely endodontic treatment.

Root canal treatment is often the last chance to save a natural tooth. Avoid extraction with timely endodontic treatment.

A root canal was once considered invasive and painful, but developments in endodontics mean this treatment is an effective intervention that avoids the need for an extraction.

What is endodontic treatment?

Endodontics is a branch of dentistry concerned with tooth pulp. When this pulp becomes infected with bacteria, this can lead to acute pain, and the tooth nerve will eventually die. When a tooth dies, extraction and replacement is the only other option.

Endodontics is a conservative treatment that can preserve your natural teeth.

When is root canal treatment needed?

When you have an infection within your tooth root, your choices for treatment are root canal therapy or extraction. An infection in the tooth pulp is usually accompanied with acute pain and occasionally swelling in your cheek or jaw. If the pain goes away temporarily, this doesn't mean the problem is fixed. It is usually an indication that the tooth nerve has died, and the pain can return more severely later.

Does root canal treatment hurt?

Root canal therapy has a bad reputation as being an invasive and painful treatment. Pain control is our top priority, and we also offer dental sedation if you are nervous about the treatment. With adequate anaesthesia, the procedure of a root canal does not hurt. The dentist will ensure you are properly numb prior to the procedure and ensure you are comfortable throughout your treatment.
