

Root canal treatment is often the last chance to save a natural tooth.

Avoid extraction with timely endodontic treatment.

#### What is endodontic treatment?

Endodontic treatment, commonly known as a root canal, is a procedure used to save a tooth that has been badly damaged by decay, infection, or injury. Instead of removing the tooth, the dentist cleans out the infected or inflamed tissue inside, disinfects the area, and seals it to prevent further issues.

#### When is root canal treatment needed?

When a tooth root is infected, treatment options are root canal therapy or extraction. Infection in the pulp often causes intense pain and sometimes cheek or jaw swelling. If pain stops temporarily, it may mean the nerve has died—pain can return worse later. Endodontics is a conservative way to save the tooth and avoid extraction.

The most common reasons for needing root canal treatment are:


- Severe toothache or sensitivity to hot and cold.
- Swelling or infection around the tooth or gums.
- Deep decay or a cracked tooth that has reached the nerve.

#### Does root canal treatment hurt?

No need to worry – modern techniques mean root canals are no more uncomfortable than getting a standard filling! The treatment actually relieves pain caused by the infection. We also offer sedation for those patients that require or prefer it.

## How long does treatment take?

The length of specialist root canal treatment can vary depending on the tooth and the complexity of the case. As a general guide:

- A straightforward root canal on a single-rooted tooth (like an incisor or canine) can usually be completed in about 60–90 minutes.
- More complex teeth such as molars with multiple canals may take 90 minutes to 2 hours.

Some treatments are completed in one visit, while others may require two or more appointments, especially if:

- There's infection that needs to settle
- The anatomy is complex
- The tooth is being retreated after a previous root canal
